

A Warm Welcome awaits you at the Caerleon Conference Centre.

The Conference Team have put together an information sheet to help you plan ahead.



How can I find you?

By road: Wales is served by the M4 which is easily accessed from the north and south of England and Scotland. Caerleon is just off the M4, less than two hours from London Heathrow, one hour from Bristol and Cardiff-Wales International Airport and 20 minutes from the Severn Bridge.

For those approaching Caerleon from Cardiff (Eastbound M4), exit at Junction 26 and follow the signs for Caerleon. The postcode is NP18 3QT.

If you approaching M4 Westbound (from London). Exit at Junction 25 and follow signs for Caerleon.

Or

M4 Eastbound and Westbound. Exit at Junction 24. Take the B4237 towards Newport. Pass the entrance to the Celtic Manor Resort on right. After another 400m turn right into Royal Oak Hill, (B4236), signposted Caerleon. Continue to the top of the hill. Stay on this road (do not take road off to the right at the top of the hill) to descend to the bottom of the hill. Continue to T junction. Turn right over stone bridge into Caerleon. Once on the one way system you will pick up signs for the Caerleon Campus.

From the North and Midlands

Take the M5. Exit at Junction 8 onto the M50 Southbound. This becomes the A40 to Monmouth, which in turn becomes the A449, which terminates at the roundabout beneath Junction 24 of the M4. Do not join the M4. At the roundabout take the B4237 towards Newport. Pass the entrance to the Celtic Manor Resort on right. After another 400m turn right into Royal Oak Hill, (B4236), signposted Caerleon. Continue to the top of the hill. Stay on this road to descend to the bottom of the hill. Continue to T junction. Turn right over stone bridge into Caerleon. Once on the one way system you will pick up signs for the Caerleon Campus

By Bus: From Newport Bus Station there are 5 buses an hour to the University between 7am and 7pm and every 30 minutes until the last bus at 11.40pm (reduced service on Sundays and Bank Holidays). Bus fare is £3 return.

By Rail: We are located close to Inter City Rail services at Newport, with direct trains to Cardiff, London Paddington and Birmingham. There is a frequent service both eastbound and westbound, with approximately four trains each hour from Newport to Cardiff. Browse the latest information and travel updates online with Trainline or National Rail Enquiries.

By air: Cardiff airport is located 12 miles outside Cardiff City Centre and 33 miles from the Caerleon Campus. You can get a taxi directly from the airport to the University which will cost approximately £55. Cardiff Airport Taxis are available for hire 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Where can I park?

Pay and Display Parking costs £2.50 per day at Caerleon and 50p for two hours. There are 800 parking spaces available. Complimentary parking may be provided depending on your event and the time of year.

Is there a cash point on site?

There are no cash points on site, however the Students Union shop will provide cash back (£10 only) with a 30p charge for usage on spends under £5.

Where can I get something to eat/drink?

The Refectory situated in the Main Building is the largest eating outlet on Campus. In addition to dining spaces there are comfy chairs where you can relax with a fairtrade coffee. Everyday you will find a choice of hot breakfast and lunchtime meals, which always includes a budget meal and a vegetarian option, look out for special offers and meal deals. Please check opening times with reception as they vary during the academic year.

The Clarence Restaurant also offers hot food and quick ready meals. There is also an adjoining patio area to eat outside.

Where can I access my emails?

There is WIFI at the Campus. WIFI passes are provided on arrival from the Main Reception.

Do you have sports facilities?
