The Conference Team have put together an information sheet to help you plan ahead.



How can I find you?

By road: Directions can be found at <http://www.southwales.ac.uk/why/location>.

Take the A473 exit signposted Llantrisant and University of South Wales. Wales is served by the M4 which is easily accessed from the north and south of England and Scotland.

- Travelling east or west on the M4 exit at Junction 32
- Follow the A470 north in the direction of Merthyr Tydfil
- Take the A473 exit signposted Llantrisant and University of South Wales
- For the main campus, take the first exit and follow the road until you reach the University
- Postcode is CF37 1DL

By rail: From Cardiff you can take the Valley Lines train to Treforest Station, which is near to the University. Trains run approximately every 15 minutes and generally leave from platform 6, heading for either Treherbert, Merthyr Tydfil or Aberdare. Make sure you get off at Treforest station not Treforest Industrial Estate. The University is adjacent to the rail station.

Train route: Cardiff Central > Cardiff Queen Street > Cathays >

Llandaff > Radyr > Taffs Well > Treforest Industrial Estate > Treforest

By air: The airport is located 12 miles outside Cardiff City Centre, and 20 miles from the University of Glamorgan. You can get a taxi directly from the airport to the University which will cost approximately £35. Cardiff Airport Taxis are available for hire 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Where can I park?

Parking is free for all delegates attending a meeting at the Conference Centre. Parking is available just outside, in the lay-by and to side of the Centre. We do work on a first come first serve basis, however if there is no availability there is an alternative car park just 5 minutes walk away and the team here would be happy to point you in the right direction. Parking in this car park is chargeable at £1 for up to 5 hours, over 5 hours is £2. The machine only takes cash but does give change.

There is a barrier just before you reach the Conference Centre, between the Students' Union and Sports Centre. Please drive up to the barrier, press the 'I' button and advise you are attending an event / course at the Conference Centre, the barrier will then be raised. The barrier will rise automatically when approached as you depart.

Is there a cash point on site?

Cash points can be found at the Students Union, there is one directly outside the convenience shop at the lower level and another inside the foyer on the ground floor level. Cash back is also provided at Stilts Food Court (minimum £5, maximum £20) with a 50p charge for usage, no minimum spend.

Where can I get something to eat/drink?

Stilts Food Court is the largest eating outlet on campus. In addition to dining space there are comfy sofas and low tables where you can relax with a coffee (the venue benefits from a Starbucks coffee kiosk). Every day you will find a choice of hot breakfast and lunchtime meals, which always include a budget meal and a vegetarian option, look out for special offers and meal deals. Please check opening times with reception.

Where can I access my emails?

The Conference Centre has Wi-Fi throughout so you have able to access the internet using a smart phone. Log in information will be provided on arrival.


Please notify us of any special requests that you may have including dietary and mobility prior to your arrival (contact details below).
